What is an Idol?

The idols mentioned in the 2nd Commandment are generally carved and crafted statues.

What are the idols of the Heart (Ezek 14:3)?

We could also call them "Ruling Desires"

Anything that you put as a priority above God.

If you are willing to sin to get something, then it is an idol of your Heart.

What is an Idol?

Words we might use today:

Control Manipulation, Aggression, Intimidation, Domination

Peace/Comfort Escapism, Avoidance, Fleeing, Unavailability

People Pleasing Deception, Insincerity, Appeasement, Compliance

Demanding, Pouting, Forceful, Merit

Prosperity/

Entitlement

Possessions Materialism, Stinginess, Discontentment

Recognition/Respect Self-Righteous, Criticism, Compromise, Self-Pity

Root of all of these is PRIDE!

Default Bent of our Heart is Spiritual Adultery

When your spiritual check engine light comes on. Ask yourself these questions:


- 1. What is the situation?
