Proverbs 6

- 16 There are six things that the Lord hates, seven that are an abomination to him:

We should judge:

1. Those we seek to influence or allow to influence us (Matt. 7:6 & 15-20)

1 "Do not judge, or you too will be judged. 2 For in the same way you judge others, you will be judged, and with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.

6 "Do not give dogs what is sacred; do not throw your pearls to pigs. If you do, they may trample them under their feet, and turn and tear you to pieces.

We should judge:

- 1. Those we seek to influence or allow to influence us (Matt. 7:6 & 15-20)
- 2. When someone we love is in sin or is being deceived in some way (Matt. 18:15 Rom. 16:17)

Matthew 18:15 If your brother sins against you, go and confront him privately. If he listens to you, you have won your brother over.

James 5: 19 My brothers and sisters, if one of you should wander from the truth and someone should bring that person back, 20 remember this: Whoever turns a sinner from the error of their way will save them from death and cover over a multitude of sins.

Galatians 6:1 Brothers and sisters, if someone is caught in a sin, you who live by the Spirit should restore that person gently.

We should judge:

- 1. Those we seek to influence or allow to influence us (Matt. 7:6 & 15-20)
- 2. When someone we love is in sin or is being deceived in some way (Matt. 18:15 Rom. 16:17)
- 3. To evaluate a person's spiritual maturity for serving in a ministry role (Titus 1:5-9 1 Tim. 3:1-13)
- 4. To discern between good and evil, sin and righteousness (Eph. 5:8-17)

We should **NOT** judge:

- 1. When my motive is anything but love for the other person
- 2. When I assume to know their motivations or all the important facts of a situation
- 3. When I am judging based on human standards rather than on God's Word (Mark 7:5-8)
- 4. When I have not dealt with my sin before pointing out someone else's (Matt. 7:1-5 Rom. 2:1-3)
- 5. When I make an authoritative pronouncement about a person's eternal destiny
- 6. When I am judging people outside of the church

When we speak against one another....
We are not considering how strongly God feels about His children

1 At that time the disciples came to Jesus and said, "Who then is greatest in the kingdom of heaven?" 2 And He called a child to Himself and set him before them, 3 and said, "Truly I say to you, unless you are converted and become like children, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven.

4"Whoever then humbles himself as this child, he is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven.
