1 Corinthians 15

1 Now, brothers, I want to remind you of the gospel I preached to you, which you received, and in which you stand firm. 2 By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you. Otherwise, you have believed in vain.

3 For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, 4 that He was buried, that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures,



Luke 19

29 As He approached Bethphage and Bethany at the Mount of Olives, He sent two of His disciples.

30 “Go to the village ahead of you,” He said. “As you enter it, you will find a colt tied there, on which no one has ever sat. Untie it and bring it here.

31 If anyone asks why you are untying it, tell him that the Lord needs it.”

Luke 19

32 So those who were sent went out and found it just as Jesus had told them. 33 As they were untying the colt, its owners asked, “Why are you untying the colt?”

34 “The Lord needs it,” they answered.

35 Then they brought the colt to Jesus, threw their cloaks over it, and put Jesus on it.

36 As He rode along, the people spread their cloaks on the road.

**5 “Say to the daughter of Zion,
‘See, your King comes to you,
gentle and riding on a donkey,
on a colt, the foal of a beast of burden.’”**

37 And as He approached the descent from the Mount of Olives, the whole multitude of disciples began to praise God joyfully in a loud voice for all the miracles they had seen:

10“Blessed is the coming kingdom of our father David!”

John 12:13...“Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!”

“Blessed is the King of Israel!”

Luke 19:38 “Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord!”

“Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!”

40 “I tell you,” He answered, “if they remain silent, the very stones will cry out.”

Revelation 5

9 And they sang a new song:

Matthew 20:25 But Jesus called them aside and said, “You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their superiors exercise authority over them.

26 It shall not be this way among you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, 27 and whoever wants to be first among you must be your slave— 28 just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many.”

John 12

23 Jesus replied, "The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified.

24 Very truly I tell you, unless a kernel of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains only a single seed. But if it dies, it produces many seeds.

25 Anyone who loves their life will lose it, while anyone who hates their life in this world will keep it for eternal life.

26 Whoever serves me must follow me; and where I am, my servant also will be. My Father will honor the one who serves me.

A Prelude Coronation of a Future King

Revelation 19: 11 Then I saw heaven standing open, and there before me was a white horse. And its rider is called Faithful and True. With righteousness He judges and wages war.

12 He has eyes like blazing fire, and many royal crowns on His head. He has a name written on Him that only He Himself knows. 13 He is dressed in a robe dipped in blood, and His name is The Word of God.

A Prelude Coronation of a Future King

Revelation 19: 14 The armies of heaven, dressed in fine linen, white and pure, follow Him on white horses.

15 And from His mouth proceeds a sharp sword with which to strike down the nations, and He will rule them with an iron scepter. He treads the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God, the Almighty.

16 And He has a name written on His robe and on His thigh:
KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.
