





Romans 8


- 5 Those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh;

- 8 Those controlled by the flesh cannot please God.


- Colossians 3:1 Therefore, since you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God.
