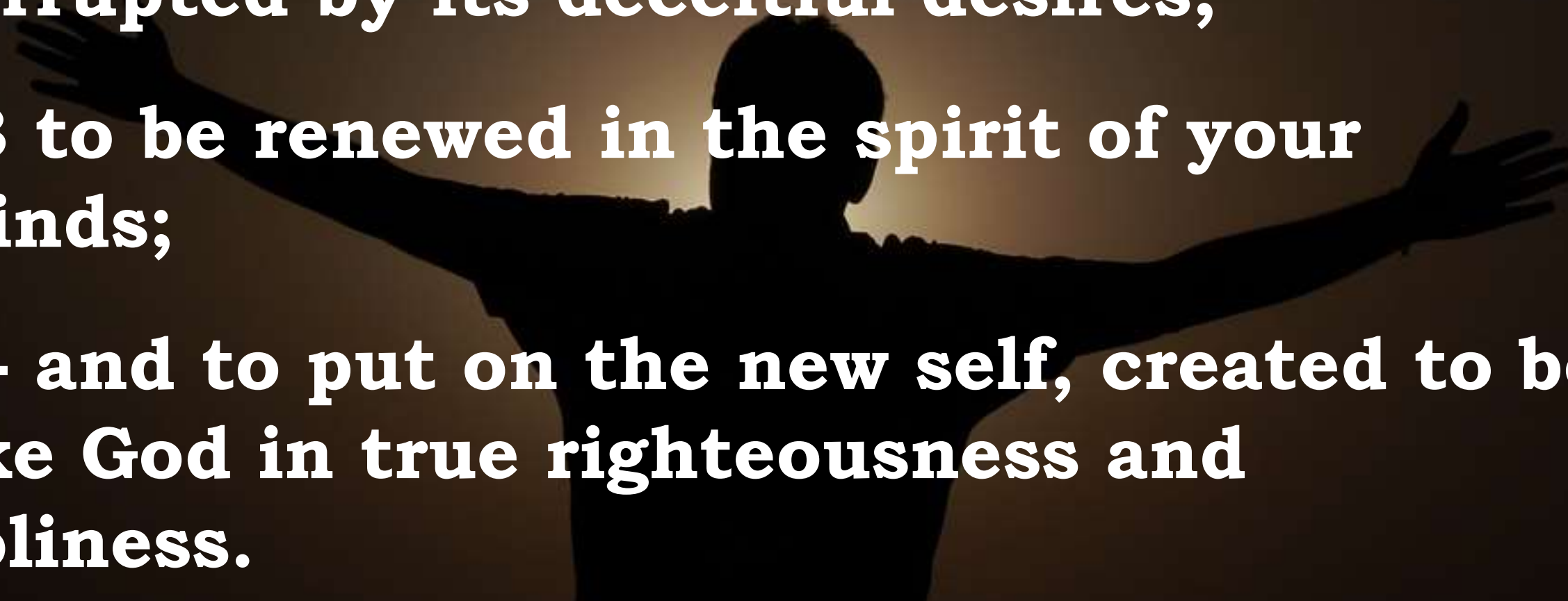

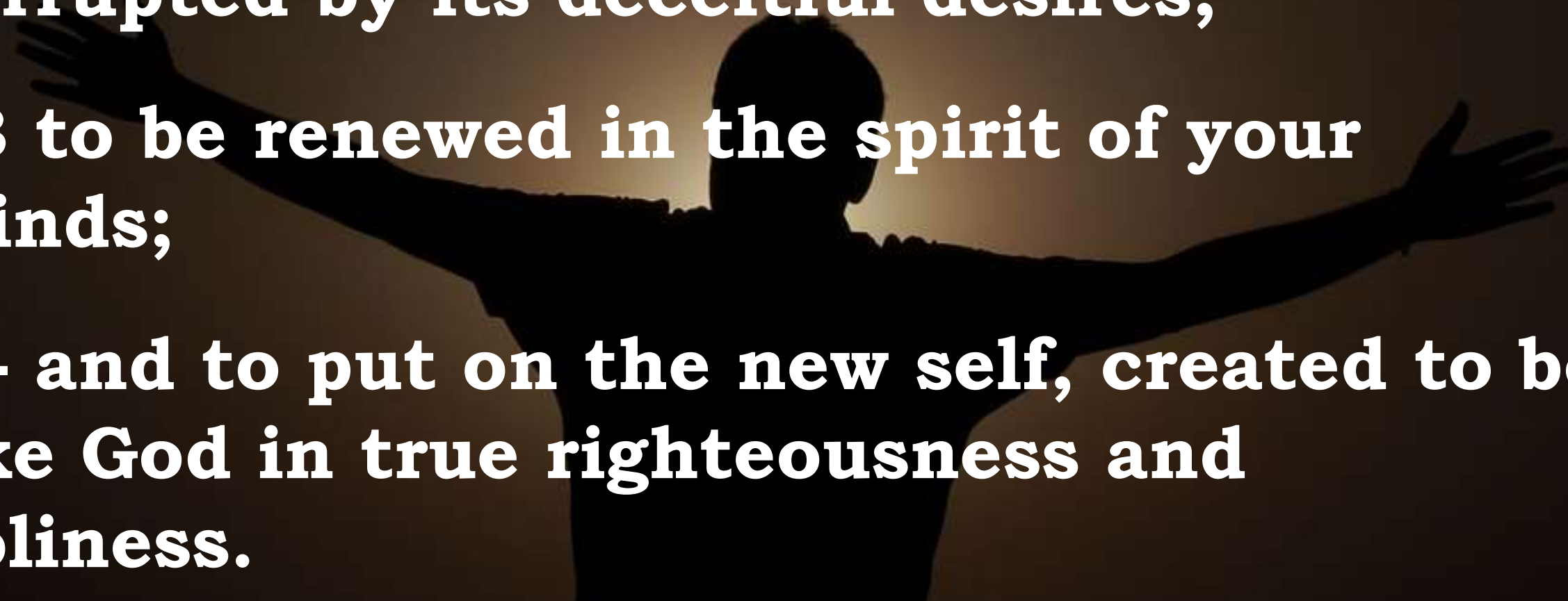

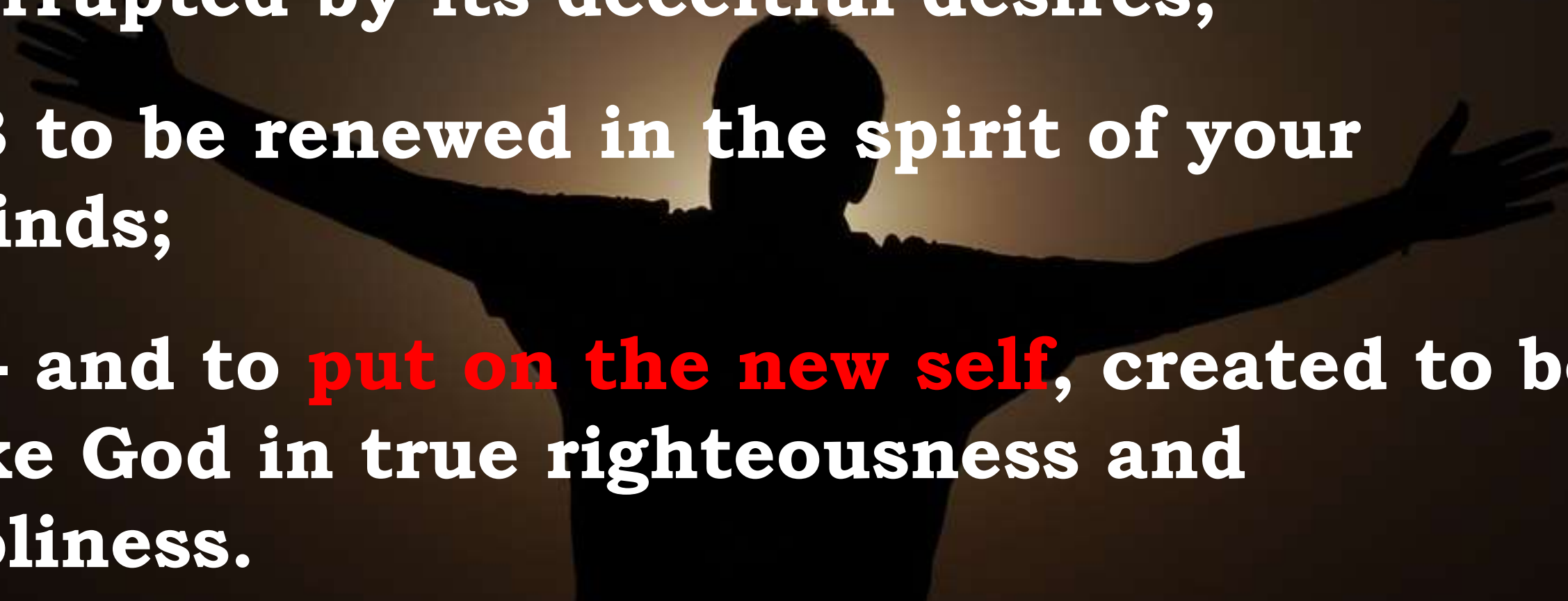

Romans 8


5 Those who live according to the flesh **set their minds** on the things of the flesh;

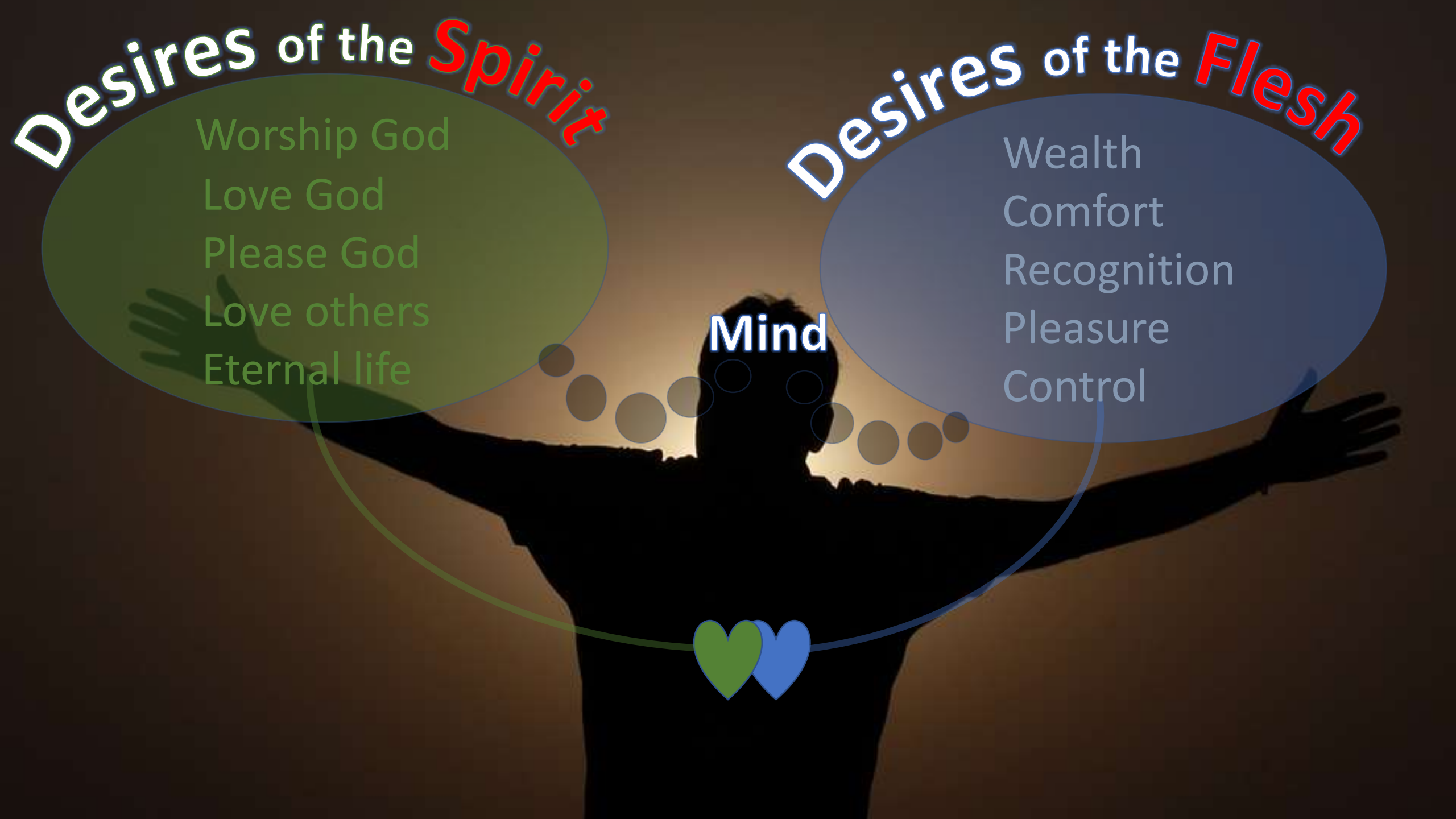



They do it for a crown that is perishable, but we do it for a crown that is imperishable.


26 Therefore I do not run aimlessly; I do not fight like I am beating the air.
